Supplies:

Lanyard String: Most important thing needed.

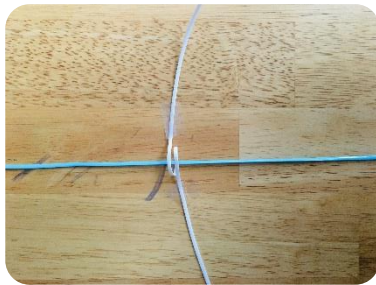
Scissors: To cut your string.

Pictures will show step by step of how to make a lanyard. (This is my childhood table so there are forever marks from the years of use!)



Step One

Cross Strings.



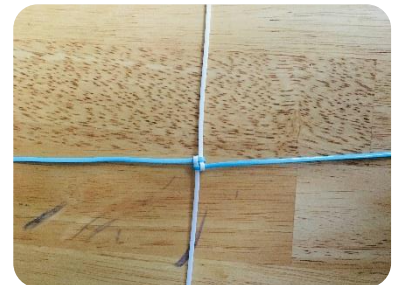
Step Two

Make two loops.



Step Three

Use the other two strings & go over and under two loops from each side. Making a square.



Step Four

Pull tight & do it again!
