Ingredients:

Borax: Very Little! (Tablespoon)

Glue: I used tacky glue because that's all I had; I recommend using (Elmers Glue). For more gooey slime you need to use more glue!

Shaving Cream: This makes the slime fluffier, use as much as needed.

Optional Items:

Food Coloring: I used this to make my slime more colorful, we need more color in our lives more than ever.

Glitter & Beads: This makes the slime look fabulous, this also provides sensory play.

*** I would recommend if the weather permits to do the slime making outside.
